



Colgan Air Publishes Partial Name List of Passengers On Flight 3407

AMHERST, N.Y. (Feb. 15, 2009) – Colgan Air today published the names of passengers confirmed aboard flight 3407 after having notified all passengers' families and requested permission to disclose the information.

The names of those passengers whose families have permitted Colgan to release the names of their loved ones are posted at www.colganair.com.

In accordance with the wishes of their families, some passengers will not be publicly identified by the airline.

The entire passenger manifest has been submitted to the National Transportation Safety Board, which is conducting the investigation of the accident. Colgan Air, which operated the flight for Continental Airlines, will continue to work closely with all authorities to learn the cause of this tragic accident.

Colgan and Continental remain focused foremost on assisting the families of the passengers and crew members involved, and those affected on the ground. An assistance center has been established in Buffalo to provide support for families' needs.
